

Tree of the Month - Oak

Oak trees have been growing on Earth for an estimated 45 million years. These massive trees begin life as acorns. From these small nuts, which contain one to two oak seeds, the mighty oak grows, reaching between 40 and 80 feet in height with a spread of 60 to 100 feet. Many animals eat acorns, including squirrels, badgers, and mice. Raw acorns are toxic to humans and have a bitter taste. However, when the tannins are leached out. acorns are safe to consume and can be eaten either whole or ground into an acorn meal or flour. The mighty oak tree is



the symbol of Zeus, as it embodies power, strength, longevity, justice, and fertility. Oak wood is very strong and beautiful. Woodworkers use it for making homes, furniture, and cabinetry. While many trees have smooth bark, the oak's bark is rough, wrinkly, and bumpy. Its bark grows very fast, allowing it to repair itself quickly, retain moisture, and survive in dry climates.

Flower - Rose



June's flower is the fragrant and beautiful rose. A symbol of love, its name comes from the Latin word rosa, which means "red." Since primitive times, roses have

been used in perfumes, medicines, and foods. Recently, archaeologists discovered the fossilized remains of wild roses over 34 million years old. Each rose color has its own meaning. A white rose symbolizes purity, a red rose means love and romance, pink stands for happiness, and yellow signals friendship.

Birthstone - Pearl



The pearl is a unique birthstone. All other birthstones are formed by inorganic substances like rocks, but pearls are created by a living thing—a mollusk, such as a

clam or a mussel. When an irritant like sand gets inside the mollusk's shell, the mollusk secretes an iridescent substance called nacre (also known as "mother of pearl") to seal it off. Pearls come in a variety of shapes, sizes, and colors, and the color depends on the kind of mollusk and its habitat. The pearl is a symbol of loyalty, friendship, and purity.
