UDALSA Updated 6/19/24

The Minnesota Department of Health issues the Uniform Disclosure of Assisted Living Services and Amenities (UDALSA) for assisted living communities to document the services, support, and amenities they offer. Prospective residents and their families can use this tool to determine which assisted living can better meet their needs, compare options at each community they are considering, and make informed decisions. This document is required as part of our assisted living licensure renewal application each year. We update it as changes in services and amenities we offer occur. With new management at Vernon Terrace, Vicki met with our team to review, and we recommended these changes to Ebenezer's Clinical Team. On June 19, 2024, we received approval on some of our suggested changes and our UDALSA was updated. Letters were sent to residents and families along with copies of the revised UDALSA. We are asking every resident or their family member to please sign a copy and return it to the front desk.
