The 2024 Summer Olympic Games are fast approaching. This summer, the sports world's elite athletes, including LeBron James, Steph Curry, Simone Biles, Scottie Scheffler, Sha'Carri Richardson and more will be going for the gold. That means you'll want to get Summer Olympics-ready. We're here to help!

The host city for the 2024 Summer Olympic Games will be Paris, France and it is scheduled to take place from Friday, July 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024, through Sunday, August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2024. NBC will broadcast at least nine hours of coverage from 9am-6pm ET each day. Some events will air on USA Network, Golf Channel, CNBC and E!. Peacock will livestream every event of the Olympic Game, including the opening and closing ceremonies and every Olympic basketball game.

Paris will play host to 32 sports at the 2024 Summer Olympics, including four new additions, breaking (or breakdancing), sport climbing (indoor rock climbing), skateboarding, and surfing.

The Opening Ceremony is schedule for July 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024. For the first time in Olympic history, it won't take place in a stadium. Instead, this summer's opening ceremony will bring sports to the heart of Paris via the Seine River. The opening ceremony will consist of boats for each national designation traveling up the Seine through the center of Paris. Going from east to west,

10,500 athletes will cross through Paris before finally landing in front of the Trocadero, where the remainder of the opening ceremony will take place.







- 4 4-ounce chicken breast cutlets, pounded thin
- 1 tsp kosher salt and fresh black pepper
- 1/2 tsp dries Italian seasoning
- 4 ounces fresh mozzarella, sliced thin
- 2 tbsp balsamic glaze

- 1 tsp extra virgin olive oil
- -1/2 tsp garlic powder
- 6 cups baby arugula
- 3 cups grape tomatoes, halved
- 2 tbsp fresh basil leaves, chopped

#### Instructions:

1. Season the chicken with 1 tsp extra virgin olive oil, salt, garlic powder, Italian seasoning, and fresh pepper. 2. Preheat the grill to medium-high, clean, and oil the grates to prevent sticking. If using a grill pan, heat on medium-high heat and spray with oil. 3. Divide the arugula, 1 ½ cups each on 4 plates. 4. Grill the chicken for 2 to 3 minutes on each side, until cooked through then top with mozzarella. Cook 1 more minute, to melt then transfer to 4 plates. 5. Top the chicken with cherry tomatoes and drizzle with balsamic glaze. Finish with fresh basil.

## Environmental Services Updates

#### IKASH/RECYCLING REMINDER:

Please remember, the wheeled containers in the trash rooms are <u>NOT</u> for trash; the trash chute is on the wall. I continue to pull plastic trash and grocery bags out of the recycling bins, and lately I have seen dirty "to-go" food trays, raw garbage, and pieces of wood dumped in.

**ALL trash** must be in a tied garbage bag and sent down the Trash Chute. The open garbage is allowing flies to breed, and nobody wants that.

The wheeled bins are ONLY for clean <u>RECYCLEABLE</u> items listed on the containers: Plastic containers, paper, glass bottles. All recyclable food containers should be thoroughly rinsed before recycling them. Cardboard boxes should be flattened and stacked behind/beside the recycling container. <u>If you have put your recyclable items in a plastic bag,</u> it is no longer recyclable and must go down the Trash Chute.

Please pay attention to the signs in the trash rooms and on the recycling containers.

**Courtesy in the Garage:** If you park in the garage, please park straight within your parking space. Parking at an angle makes it more difficult for your neighbor to get it/out of their vehicle, and nobody likes to complain about their neighbor...
