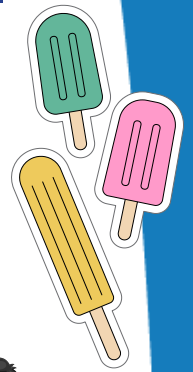

## Notes from Jennifer on the new Medical Model

As I mentioned before, thanks to those who were able to attend Family Night. If you were not able to attend, I wanted to provide a brief overview. As I noted in a previous correspondence, Stilley House will be making a transition to a more medical model. Not skilled care - but more than we have been able to do in the past. The biggest change will be medication assistance versus medication administration. At Family Night, we introduced our preferred pharmacy, Synchrony Pharmacy. While NO ONE will be forced to switch pharmacies, we will have a preferred pharmacy. We believe the services Synchrony offers will be the best choice for our residents and staff. Their services will help us limit medication errors. And they are open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. That aspect alone was so important as our facility is 24/7/365.
