We will be participating in the Alzheimer's Walk on September 14, 2024, in Lake Geneva WI.

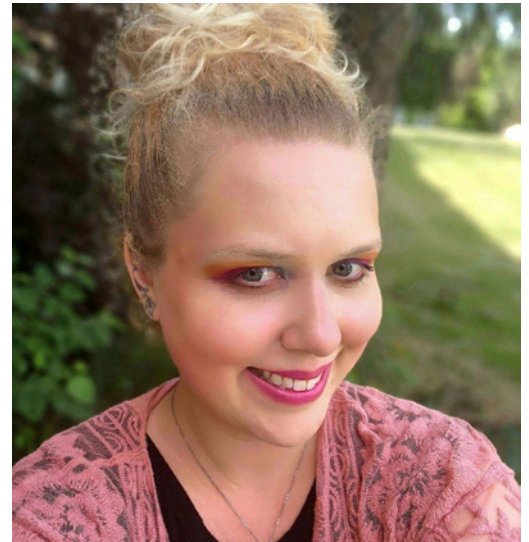
