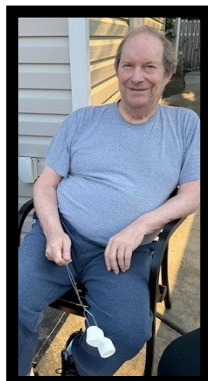
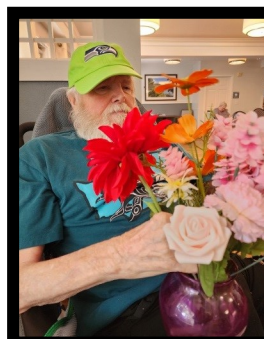
Celebrating 101 Years!!
