October Resident Spotlight: Sharie Arntz

Our October Resident spotlight is Sharie Arntz. Shari was born in Minneapolis and raised in Cambridge, MN, where she graduated from Cambridge High School. Her academic journey continued at the University of Minnesota, where she majored in Spanish and History. It was during her junior year of high school that Shari's world expanded dramatically when her family hosted the school's first-ever foreign exchange student from Finland. This transformative experience ignited her lifelong interest in different cultures and travel. During her sophomore year of college, Shari met her future husband, Floyd, at



a Lutheran Student Association gathering. Floyd, who was pursuing a Master's in Electrical Engineering at the University of Minnesota, was a strong supporter of Shari's travel ambitions. That summer, Shari worked at The Balsams resort in New Hampshire, embarking on an adventurous train journey through Canada. The following summer, Shari engaged in a research project in Spain with Student Project Amnity Among Nations (SPAN), and traveled extensively across Europe, concluding her travels with a visit to Finland. Upon her return, she was welcomed by Floyd, who had graduated and accepted a position as an assistant professor at MIT. The couple married in July following Shari's graduation in June and settled in Cambridge, MA. Shari initially worked for New England Telephone but soon faced personal challenges as her mother fell ill and passed away. Shari returned to Minnesota to support her father, and then moved back to Massachusetts to complete her teaching certificate. She taught third and fifth grades in a low-income area of Boston public schools, which deeply influenced her decision to pursue a Master's in School Counseling. Although Shari earned her Master's in School Counseling, her plans changed with the arrival of her children, John and Alayne. During this time, her father also passed away. Shari then pursued a Master's in Business Administration, combining her expertise in counseling and business to work as an HR manager for a real estate development company, a role she held for 16 years before retiring. Shari and Floyd's encouragement extended to their children's educational pursuits. Their daughter studied in Italy and earned her medical degree in Hungary, eventually completing a doctoral internship in Australia, where she met her future husband. Shari and Floyd visited Australia every summer until Floyd's illness prevented further travel. Shari's son, John, and his family live in Mankato, where his wife, Susan, serves as the City Manager. After a period of moving and transition, Shari relocated to The Pillars of Mankato in November 2022. She cherishes the closeness to her family and the friendships she has made at her new home.


