Resident Spotlight

Rosemary was born on February 21,1933 in Kingswood, in Breckinridge County. She had an older brother (just 10 months older!) named John Glenn which made for many funny stories when they were older. When Rosemary was 6 years old, while the family was living in Paducah, her dad suddenly passed away, so her mother moved the little family back to Breckinridge County where Rosemary grew up in the small town of Harned. In 1951, she graduated from Breckinridge County High School, where she was a cheerleader.

Immediately after graduation, Rosemary went to work at Fort Knox and eventually moved to post living in the girls dormitory. She spent the majority of her career as a civilian personnel job classifier in the Civilian Personnel Office where at one point, she worked with our own Joyce Bennett. During the early part of her career, she met the love of her life, Charlie Deaton at the skating rink in Radcliff. They married on April 5, 1958 and went on to have 2 children, Donna Kaye (Burch) and Glenn Deaton both of Elizabethtown.

Rosemary was always one to never let an opportunity pass and to try new things. She once owned a spider monkey that had to be given away after climbing on the neighbor's roof and pushing the bricks down the flue. She took flying lessons around 1960 and did a solo flight in a Piper I Cub. She decided in the early 60's that she wanted to take up golf. That decision would lead the entire family into a lifelong love of the game and they were charter members of Lincoln Trail Country Club when it opened in 1968. Rosemary went on to win numerous championships including several club championships. She and Charlie won couples tournaments throughout the state that are too numerous to count. She also served as a member of both the Credit Committee from 1982-85 and the Board of Directors from 1984 to 2016 for the former Fort Knox Federal Credit Union, now Abound Credit Union. Rosemary served as Secretary of the board for 12 years and received the Steve Brody Outstanding Volunteer Award for the state of Kentucky in 2012. She retired from Fort Knox in 1989 with 40 years of service.

She has held many positions at Northside Baptist Church and was a Deacon's wife at both Northside and Stithton Baptist Churches. But her greatest and best decision was when she accepted Jesus as her Lord and Savior early in her childhood at Harned United Methodist Church. Charlie passed away in December 2021 and Rosemary moved to RobinBrooke in January 2022. Rosemary has 4 grandchildren, Bevan Evans, Erin Russell, Thomas Deaton, and Ramsey Deaton and two great grandsons, Cade Evans and Reuben Russell, who are the joys of her life!
