# Spooktacular Halloween Mask Craft

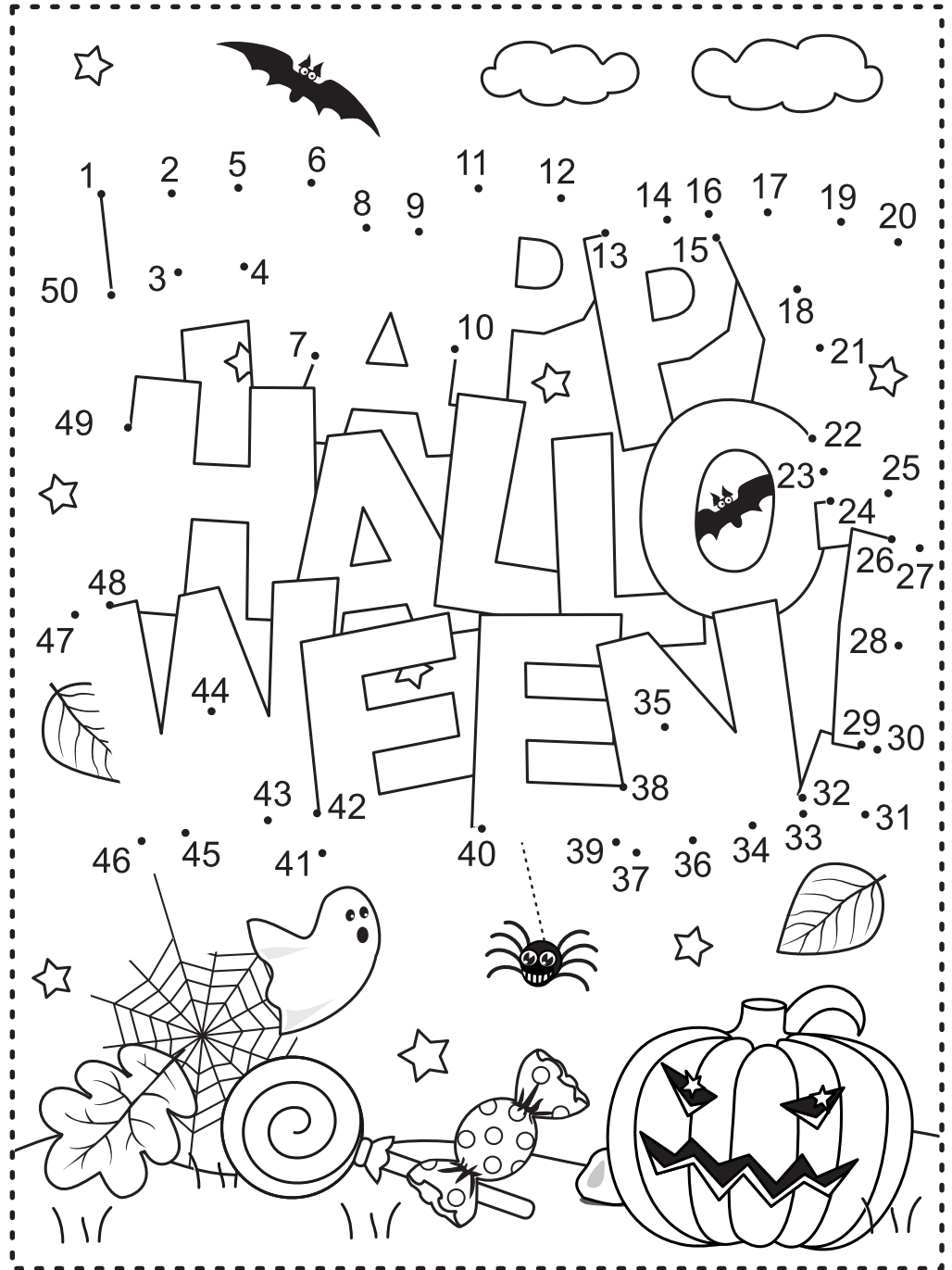
