November is Home Health Month

November is recognized as National Home Care and Hospice Month, and it's a time to honor and celebrate the dedication of home health care workers, caregivers, and hospice professionals who make a significant impact on the lives of patients and their families. There are two primary types of home health care; medical and non-medical services.

Medical home health care is often called skilled care and is provided by a medical professional such as a registered nurse or licensed therapist. Medical home care is prescribed by a doctor and billed to your primary care insurance.

Non-Medical care includes "assistance with activities of daily living." Things such as bathing, dressing, meal preparation, housekeeping, transportation to and from physician appointments and running errands for the patient. These services are usually paid out of pocket or reimbursed through a type of long-term care insurance.

During the month of November many organizations including Transitions at Home will take the opportunity to raise awareness about the benefits of home health and hospice care; recognize the hard work caregivers and professionals do every day and advocate for better support and resources in the field.
