
From the desk of Katie Keogh, Executive Director:

A Note from Pastor Kwanza Yu, Chaplain

The time after Pentecost and the season of Advent:

The season of Pentecost is the longest season of the church calendar, lasting nearly half the year (May 26 - November 30, 2024). The season begins on the Day of Pentecost when we celebrate the Holy Spirit through whom and in whom the children of God are gifted and empowered to be God's people. The liturgical color for the time after Pentecost is *green*; representing life and growth (altar hanging called 'parament' is green). Each week we hear a different story about Jesus' ministry from one of four gospels. This year we hear the Gospel of Mark.

We then enter the season of Advent, starting December 1^{st} ; the season of longing and anticipation, during which we prepare for the coming of Jesus (Advent is the Latin word for *coming*). The church year begins with Advent, as life begins with birth, starting four Sundays before Christmas. The liturgical color for Advent is *blue*; representing hope and anticipation.

Sunday worship services with Holy Communion: November 3rd, 10th, 17th, 24th at 10:00am.

<u>Thanksgiving service</u> will be held on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>November 27</u> at <u>10:00 am</u>. Come join us as we celebrate the abundance of God's creation and give thanks for God's countless blessings to us.

Wednesday Advent services will be on Dec. 4th, 11th, 18th at 10:00am.


