#### Plant of the Month - Aloe Vera

Aloe vera is a cactus-like plant that thrives in hot, dry desert climates. Amazingly, this bright-green plant is 99.5 percent water. It can grow up to 30 inches tall and have up to 21 leaves. The word aloe comes from the Arabic word alloeh, meaning "shining bitter substance." Vera comes from veritas, which means "truth" in Latin. This spiky succulent's leaves have a fibrous outer layer filled with aloe gel, which has cooling properties. It has been used for centuries to treat a range of ailments. including fever, insomnia, burns, and wounds. It is said to improve blood flow and



boost the immune system. The healing properties of the plant have been well documented, particularly for speeding wound healing, soothing sunburns, and other skincare applications. Some say Cleopatra used the aloe gel as a cosmetic. The inner layer of the plant's skin, called aloe latex, is also used as a laxative.
