Krista and Angela will present more detailed information on the services they are able to provide and answer any questions you may have regarding the services they provide with Select Rehab and Curana Health.

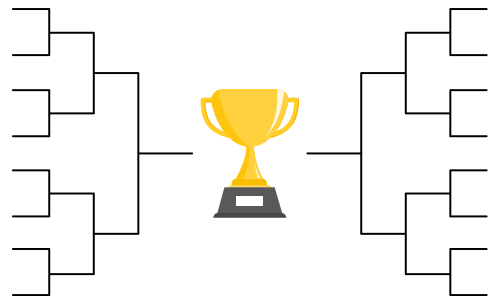
We look forward to seeing you on **Thursday, April 10th at 6:00 pm**.

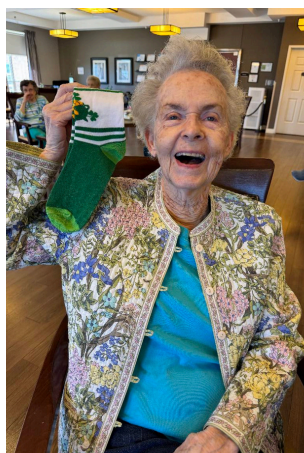


Ambassador of the Quarter Nominations
