With April being “Severe Weather Month” here is your friendly reminder on what to do in case of a watch versus a warning

Severe Weather Watch:

A tornado or severe weather watch means conditions are favorable for the formation of a tornado or severe thunderstorm. When a watch occurs please:

1. Keep radios and television sets tuned to local stations for weather information.
2. Check sky conditions periodically, especially to the west and southwest.
3. If funnel-shaped cloud is sighted, move to the tornado warning procedure immediately.

Severe Weather Warning:

A tornado or severe weather warning is issued by the National Weather Service when a tornado has been sighted or is indicated by radar.

Please immediately take cover in your bathroom, storeroom, central corridor, or in a corner of your apartment away from windows. Bring a pillow and blanket to cover your head and sit with your back to the wall. Leave any community room with large windows and proceed either to the central corridor, the underground garage or any interior room without windows.
