## FOREVER FIT: Proper Posture

A common concern for many seniors is age related changes in posture that many older individuals often experience. While bone loss, disk shrinkage and muscle loss are all common causes for changes in stature, small changes can help improve and, in some cases, reverse the effects of unwanted postural changes. If you're one of the many seniors currently experiencing an age-related symptom related to improper posture keep these tips in mind to improve the way you move and feel. 1. Do regular exercise with a focus on core strength including the abdominal, lower back, hip and pelvic muscles, 2. Talk to your doctor about calcium and vitamin D supplementation to help with bone health. 3. Practice better postural habits throughout the day. If you use a walker, be sure it's set to the correct height to minimize hunching. If you sit for longs periods, get up regularly and take breaks. A more mindful approach can dramatically help your overall health.
