## Judy Rosenmarkle



Born September 26, 1940, in Cumberland, Maryland, Judy grew up close to her younger brother, Julian. Though her parents later separated, she gained five younger siblings when her father remarried Irene, with whom Judy shared a special bond.

Judy attended an all-girls Catholic school and met the love of her life, Eddy, at just 12 years old. He attended the neighboring all-boys catholic school and played drums in a band. Despite being 3½ years her senior, Eddy was allowed to court Judy with her father's permission. They married when Judy was 16, just before Eddy was stationed in Hagerstown with the Navy.

Together, they raised four children—Ed Jr., Susan, Brian, and Steve—and were blessed with 10 grandchildren and 15 great-grandchildren. Their life took them across the country and overseas, including time in Fort Ritchie, Hawaii, New Orleans, Germany, and Pensacola. In the mid-60s, they even crossed the Atlantic aboard the SS United States with all four kids in tow.

Judy was primarily a stay-at-home mom but later worked with the Navy Exchange and Civil Service. She also ran her own small business, "Shopper Delight," helping elderly neighbors shop and run errands. Her husband, Eddy, passed away in 1998 after 41 wonderful years of marriage.

Judy lived in the Pensacola home Eddy built for her until 2020, when she moved to Arcadia. She remains close with her family and is regularly surrounded by her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. Her family appreciates every day they get to be together




