FOREVER FIT: Healthy Hydration

Healthy hydration habits are important any time of the year but they become essential during the hot, humid summer months. As we age the water content in our bodies naturally decreases, our sensation of thirst diminishes and the side effects of certain medications can greatly increase the risk for serious dehydration in seniors. The good news is that small changes to our daily routine can greatly improve our chances to stay healthy and hydrated in the months to come. Making sure there are always fluids nearby to drink throughout the day, eating plenty of water rich fruits and vegetables like cucumber and watermelon, and avoiding strenuous outdoor activities during the peak hours of the afternoon are simple changes that can make a major difference.
