

Hazel Spencer

Hazel was born on May 8, 1938, in Mobile County, Alabama. She was the third of six daughters and spent her childhood in a lively, close-knit household. Hazel attended St. Mary's Catholic School for her early education and graduated from Bishop Toolen High School in May 1956.

Hazel began working during her freshman year of high school at Allen Memorial Home, where she lived and cared for children ages 2 to 5. Each morning, she got them dressed, fed, and ready for their day before heading off to school herself. Much of her high school years were spent in this nurturing role.

After graduating, Hazel was promoted to the office at Allen Memorial Home, where she worked until marrying John Dillree in 1957. That same year, they welcomed their son John, followed by their daughter Lisa in 1960.

Hazel later became the bookkeeper and office manager for League Bros Moving & Storage. In 1967, the family relocated to Pensacola, where Hazel began a 25-year career with Haynes Van & Storage. During her time there, she developed a passion for antiques, learning how to handle, package, and store them with care.

She was also a proud member of Pilot Club International, a professional service organization for women. Hazel served as president of the Pensacola chapter in 1978 and remained an active member for 15 years.

In 1978, Hazel married Charles Spencer, a retired Air Force veteran. She left Haynes in 1989 to open her own business, "East Hill Antique Village," where she sold glassware, furniture, and collectibles. She sold the shop in 2000 but continued working in estate sales and participating in traveling antique shows until her retirement in 2023.

Hazel and Charles made Arcadia their new home in 2025. We are thrilled to have her as part of our community!
