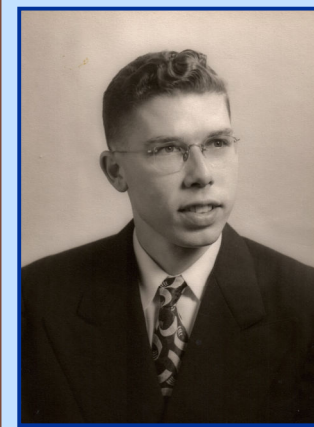

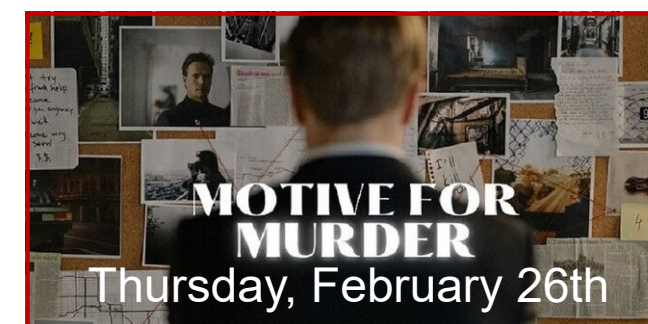

# Murder!

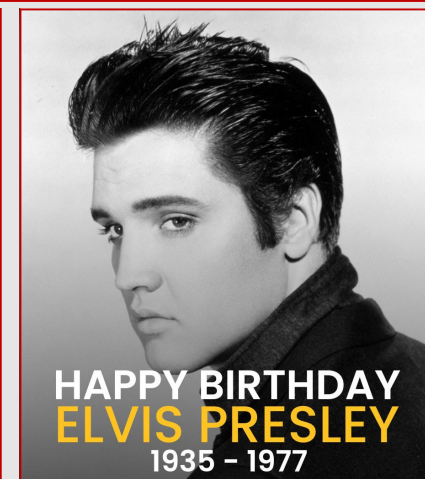
