It's Springtime at Regency on Whidbey

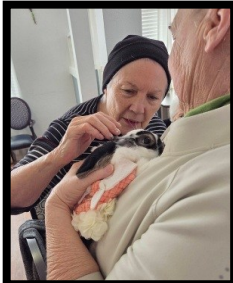
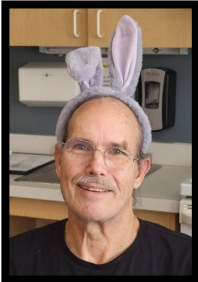
We are very excited that Spring has arrived at Regency on Whidbey. While the weather is still rainy on occasion, the sunny days seem to lift spirits and energize Residents.
