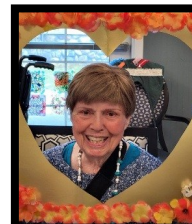
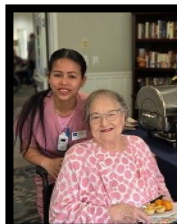
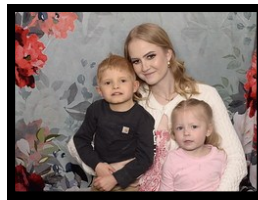

On their Birthdays and work Anniversaries, Staff receive a card with a monetary gift from you, the Residents.

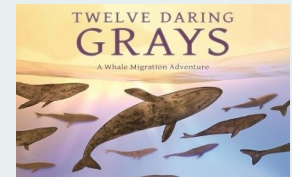
We also use Fund money to order pizza or other snacks for Staff.

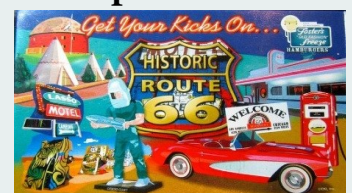

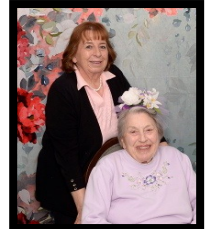
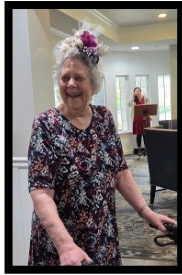
