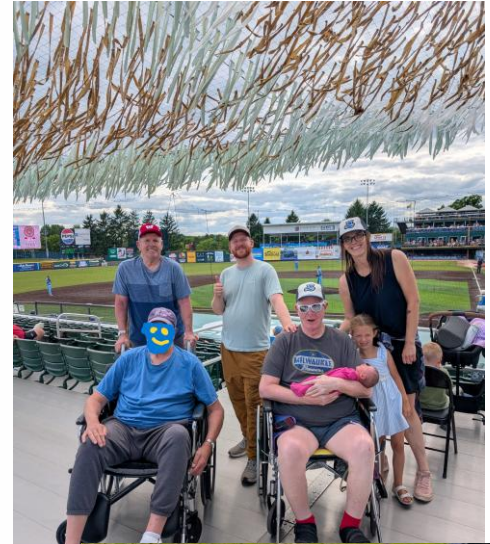


Laundry Reminder:
