Regency on Whidbey's Annual Picnic Road Trip Across America

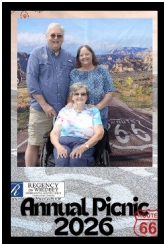
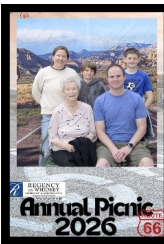
